We are pleased to announce that the Consulate General of India, Sao Paulo is now integrated with the Global Passport Seva Project (GPSP) of the Government of India.

2. The GPSP was launched by the Government of India as parts of its efforts to usher in an era of e-Governance to improve the delivery of public services, including issuance of passport services to Indian citizens. Under GPSP, the steps to apply for Passport Services online are as follows:

- Visit <https://embassy.passportindia.gov.in>
- Select the country - Brazil
- Click on 'Register' - create User ID, login and fill the application form
- Take a printout of the application form
- Affix photo and sign at the designated places
- Submit the application form along with the relevant documents including requisite fee at the Consulate in Sao Paulo

3. GPSP offer sthe following passport based services with a facility of easy and real time tracking of the status of your application:-

- (a) Apply for passport - fresh or renewal
- (b) Emergency Certificate – for one way travel to India
- (c) Police Clearance Certificate (PCC)
- (d) Surrender of India passport; and
- (e) Issue of Diplomatic/ Official passport and
- (f) Identity Certificate
